What is Age Action?

Age Action is Ireland's leading charity working to improve the quality of life of all older people and their carers.

You do not need any qualifications to join, the emphasis is on learning in an informative, social way. Everybody has something to offer through their experiences in life, their interests and own knowledge.

How does a U3A work?

Each U3A is independently managed by its own members. The idea is that the knowledge, experience and skills of the members are drawn upon to design a programme of activities. Members can conduct a session in a number of different ways by:

- Presenting material on a topic, e.g. local history, music, story telling etc
- Organising a guest speaker from a local business, college, voluntary organisation etc
